

General Education Requirements

Areas of Study

Students applying with 90 credits of undergraduate level coursework and without a bachelor's degree must have completed at least 30 general education credits prior to attending AOMA. These courses must have been completed at the baccalaureate level and at a regionally accredited institution. General education credits are drawn from the distribution areas listed below. Students must have completed at least six credits in each distribution area, with extra credits in one or more areas to make a total of 30 credits.
