

# General Education Requirements

## Areas of Study

Students applying with 90 credits of undergraduate level coursework and without a bachelor's degree must have completed at least 30 general education credits prior to attending AOMA. These courses must have been completed at the baccalaureate level and at a regionally accredited institution. General education credits are drawn from the distribution areas listed below, with examples of acceptable coursework listed within each area. Students must have completed at least 6 credits in each distribution area, with extra credits in one or more areas to make a total of 30 credits.

### Humanities & Fine Arts

6 credit minimum in such courses as:

English Literature	Philosophy

### Social & Behavioral Sciences

6 credit minimum in such courses as:

### Communications, Written & Oral

6 credit minimum in such courses as:

Interpersonal	Foreign Language
Communication	levels 1 or 2

### Natural Sciences & Mathematics

6 credit minimum in such courses as:

College Algebra	General Biology
Mathematics for Business	General Botany
Calculus	General Zoology
Trigonometry	Astronomy
Elementary Statistics	General Chemistry
General Physics	Physical Geology
