

Credential Evaluations

AOMA requires a **course-by-course** evaluation report and accepts credential evaluations from member organizations of the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES®) http://www.naces.org/.

NACES is an association of independent and private foreign educational credential evaluation services located in the United States. NACES does not provide evaluation reports; its members do. The role of an evaluation service is to analyze the information provided by an applicant, determine the US equivalent of the quantitative and qualitative information contained therein, and prepare an evaluation report that states the US equivalent of the applicant's educational qualifications. You should select a NACES member from the <u>list of Current NACES</u> <u>members</u> to have your foreign credentials evaluated.

Price, processing time, and delivery options may help to determine which service is right for you.
