POSITION: Community Class Instructor

PURPOSE:

Instructor will be able to lead and guide an hour-long class in series of movements, meditation, and or exercises

EDUCATION RELATED SKILLS:

This position exposes a student to organize, instruct, and educate a group on physical movements and general wellbeing.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

- Community Class Instructors will teach a class in their approved skillset on an agreed upon schedule thru the entire quarter. (Skillsets included but not limited to: Tai chi, Qi gong, Yoga, Martial arts, crafts, etc.)
- Instructor will have to have experience in their proposed class to teach
- Community Classes will be available for everyone and an instructor will have to be comfortable with teaching in front of diverse audiences
- Instructors will have to be mindful of participants safety at all times and be aware of modifications and clear appropriate instructions
- Opportunity to teach several different classes a week at AOMA or at approved off campus partnerships such as Seton McCarthy (2811 East Second Street, Austin, TX 78702)

DUTIES

- Available (minimum 1 day a week) for the entire quarter to host scheduled class.
- Arrive before class to set up room and stay after to clean up
- Wear loose fitting clothes/appropriate class attire to teach
- Have a prepared instruction plan for each class
- Monitor sign-in sheets.
- Answer any questions.
- Willingness to demonstration movements repeatedly for classes.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Be a current student at AOMA in good academic and financial standing with eligibility of Federal Work-Study program.
- Experience in instructing group classes
- Demonstrate professional demeanor.
- Maintain confidentiality
- Demonstrate work ethic (integrity, punctuality, confidentiality).
- Be able to physically perform a class for allotted time

RATE OF PAY: \$12.00/hour (Seeking part-time community class instructor to teach a minimum of 1.5 hours a week)

BEGINNING AND END DATES: This position is quarterly/annually, part-time.
